A lawyer by training, Veneman has practiced law in Washington, DC and California, having received her Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from UC Davis; her Masters in Public Policy from UC Berkeley's Goldman School of Public Policy; and her Juris Doctorate from UC Hastings College of Law.. Prior to joining UNICEF, Ann Veneman served as Secretary of the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA), overseeing 110,000 employees and an annual budget of \$113 billion. In 2003 she hosted the first-ever Ministerial Conference on Science and Technology, bringing together leaders from 120 nations. She held various other positions at USDA, including Deputy Secretary, Deputy Undersecretary for International Affairs and Commodity Programs and Associate Administer of the Foreign Agricultural Service. She also served as Secretary of the California Department of Food and Agriculture.
